Grab a pen and some paper. Write the question: What am I worried and anxious about? (job, finances, a relationship, etc).

What does Jesus say about worry and anxiety? What does it look like for you to surrender your worries, anxieties and fears to God? Look back at the things you wrote down. Worry and anxiety stem from approaching life's issues as if we are ultimately in charge and in control. Spend some time praying through each one. Surrender each one to God. (Repeat this step every time worry, anxiety and fear creep in to your heart and mind).

Read, reflect and spend some time praying Matthew 6:33-34.
