LA PRIMERA IGLESIA DE DIOS

La Primera Iglesia de Dios in Colonia Las Ayestas is the first Christian congregation planted in the country 67 years ago. It is located in a Colonia of Comayaguela of Tegucigalpa. Pastor Joel Rosales comes from a humble under-resourced rural area and moved to the city of Tegucigalpa as a teenager to learn a trade. He learned welding as an apprentice and later learned how to be a large engine mechanic. After coming to Christ, Joel felt called to full time ministry. Today, alongside his wife and three children, they serve and minister to hundreds of families by engaging with their community creatively through: sports ministry, vocational training classes, a feeding kitchen, and other community outreach focus ministries.
